MODALITIES FOR SPOT COUNSELING OF MBBS/BDS COURSES

The Spot Counselling for admission to vacant seats of MBBS/BDS courses for the academic session 2023-24 is scheduled to be held at OJEE CELL, Gandamunda, Bhubaneswar on 26.09.2023 and 27.09.2023.

The vacant seats available in different colleges has been notified in website (www.ojee.nic.in) along with the time schedule for reporting of candidates. Hence, those who are interested to participate in the spot counselling, have to report at the counselling venue as per the date and time mentioned against their rank/merit.

1. ELIGIBILITY:

All state merit listed MBBS/BDS candidates are eligible to participate in the Spot Round Counselling. However, candidates, who have taken admission in any Institute through All India Counselling by MCC at the end of Mop-Up Round or through OJEE Counselling at the end of 3rd Round (including upgradation), are not eligible to participate in the OJEE Spot Counselling (As per relevant orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court).

All must go through the modalities and instruction for MBBS/BDS counselling 2023 available at OJEE website.

2. **GUIDELINES**:

- 1. Admission will be done strictly as per merit.
- 2. Physical presence of the candidate is a must for participating in the spot counselling and no authorization will be entertained.
- Candidate willing to participate in this round of counselling should report at counselling hall at the schedule time as per his/her category/rank. Only one person (Guardian) will be allowed with the candidate to the counselling hall.
- 4. Candidates have to put their signature in an attendance sheet at the sitting hall.
- 5. Candidates coming after the schedule time, will be allotted a seat/college from the balance seats available at that point of time taking merit into consideration.
- 6. Provisional Admission will be done at the venue of spot counselling.

The candidates must come with all original and photo copies of testimonials like ID proof, HS / Birth certificate, +2 Mark Sheet, +2 Pass Certificate, other category certificates if applicable, Residential/Nativity Certificate (Domicile), CLC/Transfer Certificate etc, along with admission fees in shape of Bank Draft drawn in favour of "OJEE", payable at Bhubaneswar, failing which no admission will be made and the seat will be allotted to next candidate in merit. NRI Candidates to carry all relevant original documents related to their claim of NRI along with above mentioned documents.

- 7. Candidates who take admission in any category in this round, will not be allowed for any further change.
- Participation in spot counselling does not ensure admission. Seats are allotted only on merit and availability of vacancy. Once all the vacant seats are filled up, counselling will be declared closed.
- 9. If any seats remain vacant after Spot Round, then a 2nd Spot Round of Counselling shall be conducted, the schedule for which will be notified later. However, candidates, who have already taken admission in any of the rounds, including the 1st Spot Round, will not be eligible to participate in the further Spot Round Spot Counselling, if scheduled.
- 10. Participation in spot counselling does not ensure admission. Seats will be allotted only on merit and availability of vacancy. Once all the vacant seats are filled up, counselling will be declared closed.

Govt. Institutions: Rs. 37,950/- per annum Private Institutions (Hi-tech MCH, Bhubaneswar): Rs. 6,50,000/- per annum Private Institutions (Hi-tech MCH, Rourkela): Rs. 5,50,000/- per annum DRIEMS Institute of Health Sciences & Hospital - Rs.6,50,000/- per annum

B) FEES FOR BDS COURSE (per annum)

Govt. Institutions: Rs. 37,950/- per annum Private Institutions (Hi-tech MCH): Rs. 3,00,000/- per annum

C) NRI Candidates to pay Four Times the fee of Private Institutions.
