2.	Fill the Application carefully and legibly without overwriting and in one's own hand writing. All pages in the application should be signed in full by the applicant.
3.	All the enclosures prescribed should be Self – Attested true photocopies only. The Originals should be produced only at the time of Counselling and Admission.
4.	Application with incomplete or insufficient particulars or without enclosures or those received after the last date mentioned will be summarily rejected. Further, request for extension of time for submission of documents beyond the prescribed date and time shall not be entertained under any circumstances.

5. Service Candidates Service Candidates should forward their application only through the proper channel with the remarks of the forwarding authorities in the format prescribed in the Application form. It should compulsorily reach on or before the last date as mentioned above. If not, Applications will be summarily rejected irrespective of the date of submission by the Applicant and date of forwarding by the competent authority. 13.	ALLOTMENT OF SEATS: The Selection Committee will allot seats to the Colleges and Branches of study based on the merit and following 200 points roster depending upon the seat matrices provided by the affiliating University and subject to the availability of seats at the time of individual's turn. If candidates of particular community is not available in the merit list, the next turn will be considered till filling up of all seats based on 200 points roster.

14.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. A pass in BUMS Degree course conducted by The Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University or any other recognized Indian University. ii. Completion of Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internship (CRRI) on or before the date of Counselling for Admission to M.D. Unani. iii. Should have been registered with Tamil Nadu Board of Indian Medicine before actual date of Counseling. iv. Candidate should have appeared in AIAPGET 2022 (UNANI) and should have secured a place in the common merit list arrived at by MoA / NTA AIAPGET 2022 (UNANI). v. It shall be necessary for the candidates to obtain minimum of marks at 50th percentile in AIAPGET 2022 (Unani). However, in respect of candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes, Scheduled Castes (Arunthathiyar), Scheduled Castes, Most Backward Classes and Denotified Community, Backward Classes (Muslim), Backward Classes, the Minimum marks shall be at 40th Percentile in AIAPGET 2022 (Unani). In respect of candidates with Bench Mark disability the minimum marks shall be at 45th percentile for General Category candidates and

16.	The Candidate should be a Citizen of India and should have undergone B.U.M.S. Course in the State of Tamil Nadu. Candidates of Tamil Nadu nativity who have completed B.U.M.S. Course in other States shall furnish a Certificate of Nativity in Tamil Nadu issued by a competent authority only in the specified format prescribed in the application, and should also produce the Eligibility Certificate from the T.N. 20.	<p>DECLARATION OF MERIT LIST</p> <p>On receipt of AIAPGET 2022 (Unani) common merit list declared by MoA / NTA AIAPGET Secretariat, the marks scored by the candidates for a maximum of 100 will be computed to a maximum of 90 marks upto Two Decimals for the purpose of arriving State Merit list.</p>								

21.	Experience marks will be calculated for each applicant in the following method. One (1) mark for each completed year after the completion of CRR I shall be awarded as marks for experience for both Service/ Non-Service candidates to a maximum of Ten marks as on 31 - 08 - 2022. Two marks will be awarded to each completed year of Government Service in hilly areas and it will be limited to a maximum of Ten marks. Altogether the total marks awarded for Experience/ Hill station service will be restricted to Ten marks to all candidates. Fractional values of a year will not be counted for awarding marks for experience and hill station service.
22.	The merit list will be arrived at by taking together the computed marks of the marks obtained in the AIAPGET 2022 (Unani) by the applicants and the marks awarded for Experience/ Hill station service or both. Tentative rank list will be published on the official website www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in after completion of scrutiny of all application received for the academic year 2022 - 2023.

24.	<p>Personal appearance during counselling along with all original certificates / documents is compulsory for all eligible candidates applying for admission to the Post-Graduate courses to verify identity with reference to the attested copies enclosed with the Application. The candidates will be called as per Rank in Merit list and the seats will be filled as per Rank in Merit list and 200 point Roster as per GO MS. 75 from Human resources management (K) Department dt. 26.07.2022 modified roster, since the available number of seats is less than 8 in each speciality.</p> <p>If candidates are not available in a particular community, then the next the next community(number) in 200 Point roster will be given opportunity to opt.</p> <p>In any case candidates without original certificates / documents who attended first phase counselling, shall NOT be allowed to participate in second or subsequent phases of counselling No separate letter for counselling will be issued. Candidates who are absent at the time of Counselling will not be considered for selection and no protest will be admitted in this regard.</p>
25.	<p>Allotment of Branches will be made at the time of Counselling to be conducted by the Selection Committee at the campus of the Arignar Anna Government Hospital of Indian Medicine, Arumbakkam, Chennai 106 based on rank in the merit list. Branch once opted and allotted to the candidate at the time of Counselling is final and cannot be changed subsequently under any circumstances for that particular Phase of counselling.</p>
26.	<p>If any vacancy arises in Phase I, the seats will be filled in Phase II as per the Rank in merit list and communal reservation. Candidates who were absent in Phase I or who have not joined the allotted course in Phase I will not be permitted to attend Phase II.</p>

27.	The candidate cannot claim the seat which was available during Phase I, during his/or her turn, in subsequent phases.
28.	Candidates allotted seat in special category are not eligible for General Counselling.
29.	The number of seats available for counselling may be changed without notice. However, the exact distribution of seats, Specialty wise will be displayed on the notice board at the Selection Committee, Directorate of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy before the commencement of Counselling on receipt of seat matrices from the affiliating University before the counselling schedule for P.G. courses.
30.	The selection will be made by counselling based on Merit and by applying the 200 points Roster method followed by the Government of Tamil Nadu, since the available number of seats is less than 8 in each speciality.
31.	Any remaining unfilled seats for want of adequate number of eligible candidates belonging to SCA communities shall be filled by candidates belonging to SC community other than Arunthathiyars as per merit and vice versa (G.O. Ms. No. 55 P&AR Dept. dt: 08- 04- 2010)
32.	Any remaining reserved seats in ST quota for want of adequate number of eligible candidates belonging to ST community shall be allotted to candidates belonging to SC community as per merit (G.O.(Ms) No.77 H&FW Dept. MCA-1 dt: 24-02-2011)
33.	Any remaining unfilled seats in BCM Community for want of adequate number of eligible candidates after exhausting the merit list shall be filled up on merit basis by candidates belonging to BC community without exceeding the quota for BC community as a whole. No allotment order will be issued if payment is not made immediately and the seat will be allotted to the next meritorious candidate. After receipt of the joining report from the Principal, Govt. Unani Medical College, Chennai, this amount will be transmitted to the college concerned to be adjusted with the tuition fees to be paid by the candidate. If the candidate fails to join the course within the stipulated day / time after getting allotment order he/she shall forfeit this amount and any other payments done by him/her and also lose the right to join the current session of the MD (Unani) Programme.</p> <p>Processing Fees All the candidates appearing for M.D (<u>Unani</u>) course counselling will have to remit a non-refundable amount of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) by Cash towards processing fee for counselling.</p>

X. STIPEND TO NON-SERVICE CANDIDATE

The Post Graduate students shall be subject to the rules, regulations, conventions and practice being followed in the hospital and the concerned medical college and code of conduct, rules etc., as laid down by the Government, T.N. Dr. M.G.R. Medical University and the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine, New Delhi from time to time.
50.	In case of breach of any such rules, regulations etc., as stated above, the Principal, Government Unani Medical College, Chennai, shall take appropriate disciplinary action against such student including the disqualification of the student to continue further post graduate studies and communicate the same to the T.N. Dr. M.G.R. Medical University.
51.	SALARY FOR THE SERVICE CANDIDATES IN LIEU OF STIPEND: Candidates who have been regularly appointed in the Tamil Nadu Medical Service alone will be paid salary as per Government orders in force. 8. The guidelines prescribed for the issue of Nativity Certificate and they are as follows as per Letter No. RA. V(B)16932/2000, dated 3-4-2000 of the Special Commissioner and Commissioner of Revenue Administration, Chepauk, Chennai- 600 005.
